



Vulnerable Adults Protection Policy

This policy is to promote good practice by ensuring that all Isle of Thanet Table Tennis Association members;

- Are fully aware of their responsibilities with regard to protection of vulnerable adults.
- Safeguard and promote the interests and wellbeing of vulnerable adults with whom they are working.
- Respond appropriately to concerns.
- Take all reasonable and practical steps to protect vulnerable adults from harm, discrimination or degrading treatment.
- Respect and promote vulnerable adults rights, wishes and feelings.
- Make informed and confident responses to protection issues.

The TTE Protection Policy and Guidelines will:

- Offer safeguards to young people and Safeguarding vulnerable adults, coaches, staff, officials and volunteers.
- Help to maintain high standards of professionalism and practice at all levels of the sport.
- Implementation procedures that demonstrate a commitment to:
- The provision of support, appropriate training (and updating) and adequate supervision of coaches, staff and members to enable them to work together with parents, coaches and other organisations to ensure that the welfare and needs of children and young people and vulnerable adults remain paramount.
