The Kent League is for teams from Leagues affiliated to the KCTTA.

We invite and welcome you to enter team(s) for the coming season.

The entry form is provided with this letter.

Entries to be received by 10th August 2018 but we encourage submission asap prior to this date.

There is no separate entry fee for an affiliated league. County Affiliation gives right of entry.

Please read The Kent League Constitution and Rules for full details.

Should you have any queries please let me know so we can assist you.

We currently have three divisions, our aim is between 8 max and 6 min teams in any division.

Teams each play once against all others in their division.

Teams are of the three person format playing nine singles and one doubles.

Teams may comprise players of any age and gender.

The league placings from 2017/18 mean the division places secured for each League in the coming 2018/19 season are as follows (in alphabetical order):

Division 1 - Ashford A, Canterbury A (promoted), Gravesend A, Maidstone A, Medway, North West Kent, West Kent A, West Kent B. Vacancies nil, subject to all teams taking up their allotted places.

Division 2 - Ashford B, Canterbury B (promoted), Folkestone A, Gravesend B, Sittingbourne, West Kent C. Vacancies 2no, subject to all teams taking up their allotted places.

Division 3 - Ashford C, Gravesend C, Isle of Thanet, Maidstone C (or B), West Kent D. Vacancies 3no.

Teams may apply for a division other than their secured place. New and returning teams will be welcome to apply. All such entries will be considered and all teams must provide assurances they can fulfil their fixtures, as in accordance with the Constitution.

We confirm the personal data listed on the Entry Form is not used for anything other than advising the participating Kent League teams your contact details. Information displayed on the KCTTA web site relating to Kent League matches uses only player names and no contact references.

We look forward to your League participation in this long running County competition.
